1. 13th July, 2016 – A Historic Step

Today was a landmark day for Brajkishore Netraheen Balika Vidyalaya when the Vodafone Call Centre was inaugurated on the School premises by senior Vodafone personnel. It was a dream come true for the Institution since the Call Centre would provide an avenue of employment for the educated and trained blind girls leading to their economic independence. The Call Centre for the blind would be the only one in the whole northern part of the country.

2. **5th September, 2016** - Teacher's Day was celebrated at the School and the children participated by preparing and delivering speeches on Dr. S. Radhakrishnan. XISS students organized the whole Programme very efficiently.

3. **2nd October, 2016** – Mahatma Gandhiji's and Lal Bahadur Shastri's birthdays were celebrated at the School. Discussions with the students on the lives of these great personalities were conducted by XISS volunteers.

October, 2016 - Diwali was celebrated enthusiastically at the School by the children along with visiting students of XISS who enjoyed the evening with them. Earthen pots were lighted, crackers were burnt and sweets were shared by all. A lamp was floated in the sky which was a new experience for the children. We thank the students of XISS who spent the evening with the children and made them happy.

4. **14th Novemeber, 2016** - Children's Day was celebrated at the School along with XISS students. Music and dance programme was put up by the children for the benefit of the guests as well as speeches were made on Pandit Jawahar Lal Nehru, the first Prime Minister of India.

15th November, 2016 - Jharkhand Foundation Day was celebrated at the Institution by the children putting up a play on Environment which was highly appreciated. A Quiz Contest was also organized in which the children participated.

5. Chess and Computer training classes are continuing under the guidance of trained teachers and the girls have acquired some proficiency in computer operation.
6. **December, 2016** - The visually challenged Vodafone Call Centre Operators received their first monthly payment and were overjoyed with the earnings got through their hard work and special skills learnt.
7. **January, 2017** – Saraswati Puja was organized by the girl students on the campus and children fasted for the occasion.

January 26, 2017 – Republic Day Celebrations

Republic Day was celebrated with great fanfare at the School with the active participation of the students from Xavier Institute of Social Service (XISS), Ranchi.

Various programmes were put up by the school girls that included a variety of speeches, poems, music and songs. A skit was also presented on the current topic of Demonetisation. The audience enthusiastically encouraged the students and appreciated the effort put in by the school children. Snacks were distributed.

8. All other regular programmes of the School continued as usual like periodic feeding of the students by the donors, medical visits by CCL Team, computer training classes for the visually impaired, etc.
9. The Institution has added post-Plus-2 Graduation programme also in the teaching curriculum and two students have been taken in this course from this year.
